Zoning Administrator Heather McWhorter stated that the Applicant is planning to build a livestock building and eventually expand to the 10,000 head of a combination of sheep and cattle. No homes exist within the required setback of 1,980 feet.

The Discussion consisted of the following input:

- Property is zoned AG-1-Agriculture Intensive.
- Marshall Petersen would like to operate a Large Animal Feeding Operation with a combination of sheep and cattle.
- Marshall applying for up to 10,000 animal units but currently plans to have 1600 Ewes and 100 or less cows.
- Marshall has had contact with DEQ and currently does not need a DEQ permit however, as the operation grows a DEQ permit will be required.
- Marshall has no history of verified complaints filed in Pierce County in the last 5 years.
- Marshall is a resident of Pierce County, Nebraska.
- Marshall plans to build a barn to keep animals inside.
- Marshall will use a bed pack system and haul off manure.
- Entrance will be built on Northwest corner of property.
- Has had contact with County regarding the minimum maintenance road and building it up.
- Meets all required setbacks.
- Will not generate excessive noise.

The Public Hearing for Marshall Petersen's Conditional Use Permit is to be held immediately to follow on May 17, 2021.
