He has a 2014 CUP for 1200 head in 16-27-4 and has received no complaints. He is being represented by Andy Scholting from Nutrient Advisers.

- Property is zoned AG-1-Agriculture Intensive.
- James Currently operates a Livestock Feeding Operation.
- James Aschoff is expanding the current operation with an additional 1200 head.
- James has DEQ Approval.
- James has no history of verified complaints filed in Pierce County in the last 5 years.
- James is a resident of Pierce County, Nebraska.
- James has a Nutrient Management Plan.
- Meets all required setbacks.
- Will not generate excessive noise.
