WHEREAS, Madison County, Nebraska does participate in said Region 4 Behavioral Health System, the designated regional mental health authority with northeast Nebraska.

Be it therefore resolved that the Chairperson of the Madison County Board of Commissioners be and hereby is authorized to enter into an agreement for the participation in Region 4 Behavioral Health System under the Interlocal Cooperation Act of the State of Nebraska.

Motion made by Schmidt and seconded by Stinson to approve the regular agenda for the meeting. Roll call vote: Ayes, Stinson, Schmidt, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.

Region 11 Emergency Management Coordinator Bobbi Risor discussed the upcoming updates to the Local Emergency Operations Plan, LEOP. LEOP provides information to first responders to educate community members on what procedures to follow during an emergency. Region 11 covers emergency management for Antelope, Pierce, and Madison Counties. LEOP is required to have an updated plan every five years however, Madison County is not due to update until 2022. Bobbi explained that the State of Nebraska has received a grant and the LEOPS in all 93 counties will be updated this year. Each county will now have their own LEOP plan online and will no longer receive a binder. One of the benefits to having the plan online is it will no longer be required to update every five years. Instead, updates will occur as soon as changes are made. Chairman Troy Uhlir stated that it would be good to have an option to print these plans off in case there were to be a time that the power goes out and the internet is not accessible. It is projected to have all of the data completed to have these plans be uploaded online by August 2021.

Bobbi explained that two weeks ago all four dispatch centers within Madison, Antelope, and Pierce Counties are now able to send an alert through the Integrated Public Alert and Warning System, IPAWS. This has been a project in the works since October 2019 and has now been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, FEMA. This warning will only be used for large disasters that occur. For example, if the City of Norfolk needed to evacuate due to a flood, the dispatch center is notified of the evacuation and they will set off this IPAWS alert. This alert will be sent to cell phones, tablets, radio stations, and the ticker tape over the bottom of the TV. Bobbi stated that having the advantage to designate the IPAWS alert to go off in either all three counties or to one specific area will prevent those who are not in the area from receiving the alert. If someone were to drive into the affected area their cell phone will receive an alert stating the situation that is occurring in that area. This IPAWS alert is to be used for large drastic events such as floods, fires, civil emergencies, law enforcement warnings, and hazardous material alerts. This IPAWS alert also has the capability to do the National Weather Service. Commissioner Ron Schmidt was concerned what the additional costs would be to the county to have this update occur. Bobbi stated that this update is paid for by FEMA, therefore there will be no costs added to the county. She further explained that there are some additions that can be added to the alert system but would prefer to see how IPAWS works for the three counties before adding on additions.

After 18 years of service, Chairman of the Madison County Joint Planning Commission Board Richard Grant announced that he will be retiring from his position in January. Planning and Zoning Administrator Heather McWhorter explained that in previous years, if an individual was resigning from their position on the board they were able to find their own replacement. She appreciates when a board member finds their replacement because it can be a difficult task to find volunteers for an unpaid position. Each joint planning board has ten members, five are designated to at large areas and five are designated to towns. Ms. McWhorter has been short two members in Pierce County's joint planning board for two years and did not want to see this happen for Madison County. Therefore, she submitted Mr. Grant's resignation to the Norfolk Daily News and added a listing for those who would be interested in the volunteer position to contact her office.

Madison County's Sign Supervisor Travis Amen has been interested in serving on the joint planning commission for about four years now. The joint planning commission spoke with Travis and noted that his background of knowing all of Madison County due to working for the county's road department, grew up in an agriculture lifestyle, and also lives in Battle Creek that he would be a great candidate to the joint planning commission. Chairman Troy Uhlir was concerned if there could be a conflict of interest due to Travis also working for the county's road department. County Attorney Joseph Smith explained that a court would say that it's not a conflict of interest however, there could be an argument going up to court. He stated that this is not the type of conflict that would cause you to lose something in court. Travis stated that he understood that this position is an unpaid volunteer position, therefore, he will not let his time on the board count towards his work time. The joint planning commission typically meets once a month and is in the evenings so this should not affect his working day. Ms. McWhorter explained pending Travis's appointment, he will fill the at-large seat which is the same position that Mr. Grant held. The commissioners agreed that Travis's background and knowing all of Madison County from working in the department he will be great addition to board.

Motion made by Stinson and seconded by Schmidt to approve the appointment of Travis Amen to Madison County Joint Planning Commission for a three year term effective February, 2021. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, Stinson, Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.
