

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

Madison, Nebraska

June 14, 2016

The Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Nebraska met in regular session at 9:30 A.M.

Advance notice of meeting was published in the Thursday, June 9, 2016 edition of The Norfolk Daily News and posted on the Madison County website. A copy of said notice was provided to each Board member. An affidavit of acknowledgment of receipt of notice of meeting as published was executed.

Following a moment of Silence and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, Vice-Chairman Christian Ohl called the meeting to order and notified the public of the copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the meeting room.

Present: Commissioners Christian Ohl and Ron Schmidt, County Clerk Nancy Scheer, and County Highway Superintendent Richard Johnson. Norfolk Daily News reporter Jerry Guenther and WJAG reporter Paul Hughes were present until 9:58 A.M. Absent, Commissioner Jim Prauner.

Motion was made by Ohl and seconded by Schmidt to add an emergency item to the agenda to discuss extension of the open enrollment period for health insurance for the 2016-2017 fiscal year. Roll call vote: Ayes, Ohl and Schmidt. Absent, Prauner. Nays, none. Motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Christian Ohl read the following consent agenda items into the record:

Motion was made by Schmidt and seconded by Ohl to approve the regular agenda as amended. Roll call vote: Ayes, Ohl and Schmidt. Absent, Prauner. Nays, none. Absent, Prauner. Motion carried.

Pursuant to published legal notice in the May 26, 2016, June 2, 2016, and June 9, 2016 editions of The Norfolk Daily News, Vice-Chairman Ohl announced that a public hearing would be held to receive citizens' comments regarding the vacation or abandonment of the cul-de-sac on Elkhorn Street lying to the south of Lot 6, North Fork Industrial Park located Southeast of Norfolk.

County Highway Superintendent Richard Johnson reported that Dan Geary and Mr. Hradec are involved in doing some re-platting in this area which involves extending Elkhorn Street to tie into Channel Road. He said that if this is completed, the cul-de-sac is not required. He reported that he advised the land owners that if they don't go all the way to Channel Road, the County needs an easement so snow removal equipment can turn around. He explained that, in his opinion, there should be quit claims deeds from the County and City of Norfolk to the developers and then when the cul-de-sac is vacated, the developers in turn would dedicate the new street back to the public. He stated that this would need to be approved by the Norfolk City Council before the County could vacate the cul-de-sac, so the item will be added to the next City Council agenda. He said that the State law does not allow the County to make a decision at the same meeting when the public hearing is held, so a resolution can be added to a future meeting agenda. He recommended that the cul-de-sac be vacated.

Vice-Chairman Ohl opened the public hearing at 9:37 A.M.

Larry Hradec, owner of Hradec Diesel and D & L Towing reported that he is retired, but still owns the property. He testified that the cul-de-sac has been useless for the last 20 years. He reported that when he first moved to his property, the cul-de-sac was used; but, eventually his yard opened up and is being used for people who need to turn around. He stated that it works well for people to use his yard to turn around and he hasn't had any problems. He explained that D & L doesn't use the cul-de-sac even though the lease has a clause stating that D & L has an easement for full use of the right-of-way into their lot, so the cul-de-sac hasn't been used for the past 20 years. He reported that Dietz drives across it; but, the only people who turn around on the cul-de-sac are individuals who drive in and out to look around. Mr. Hradec reported that the cul-de-sac is worthless and Dietz has part of his fence on it. He stated that if vacation of the cul-de-sac will make the situation for himself, Dan Geary, and other involved parties, he was in favor of vacating the cul-de-sac.

No one testified during the hearing in opposition of vacation of the cul-de-sac.

County Clerk Nancy Scheer presented a copy of the proof of publication from the Norfolk Daily News reflecting that the notice of the public hearing was published for three consecutive weeks prior to the hearing. In addition, she reported that notices of the public hearing were sent by certified mail to the adjacent landowners of Miller Sal LLC and Hradec Holdings LLC.

Vice-Chairman Ohl closed the public hearing at 9:41 A.M.

No action was taken.

Motion was made by Ohl and seconded by Schmidt to approve a special enrollment period for the health insurance plan for Madison County for the months of July and August, 2016, pending approval from NACO Benefit Services.

During discussion on the motion, Vice-Chairman Ohl explained that the special enrollment period would accommodate employees making changes to their health insurance based upon plan changes for the 2016 – 2017 fiscal year. Commissioner Schmidt stated that the Social Security office has a delay in processing Medicare applications by July 1st, so extension of the enrollment period would make it possible for employees to complete the necessary paperwork for the next plan year.

Roll call vote: Ayes, Ohl and Schmidt. Absent, Prauner. Nays, none. Motion carried.
