July 5, 2023

The Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Nebraska met in regular session at 9:30 A.M.

Advance notice of meeting was published in the Saturday, June 24, 2023 edition of The Norfolk Daily News and posted on the Madison County website. A copy of said notice was provided to each Board member. An affidavit of acknowledgment of receipt of notice of meeting as published was executed.

Following a moment of Silence and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, Chairman Troy Uhlir called the meeting to order and notified the public of the copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the meeting room.

Present: Commissioners Ron Schmidt, and Troy Uhlir, County Clerk Anne Pruss, and County Highway Superintendent Richard Johnson.
Absent: Eric Stinson. Norfolk Daily News reporter Jerry Guenther was present.

Commissioner Schmidt read the following consent agenda items into the record:

WHEREAS, this Resolution is to formally notify State of the proper completion of the Project according to the terms of the Program Agreement.

Be It Resolved: by the Board of Commissioners of Madison County:

- (1) The Project, for Structure No. C005900515, C005900920, and C005913210 has been properly constructed by County and its contractor, in accordance with the terms of the Program Agreement.
- (2) The bridge was constructed in strict compliance with
 - (a) the plans and specifications including any State-approved change orders,
 - (b) all applicable design standards, and
 - (c) the conditions and requirements of the Program Agreement.
- (3) County understands that it is the owner of the bridge, and that it is solely responsible for the design, inspection, construction, reconstruction, repair, and operation of the bridge and roadway and is responsible for meeting any environmental or other post-construction permit or legal commitments applicable to the project
- (4) The project costs were fair, reasonable and necessary for the proper construction of the project.

Planning and Zoning Administrator Heather McWhorter explained that purpose of the hearing is to receive public comments concerning the application of Brandon Seifert to construct a home on less than 40 acres on WIESE'S WEST LOT SPLIT described as PT NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 23 North, Range 3, West of the 6th P.M. Madison County, Nebraska. This property is located approximately 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles south and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of the City of Battle Creek along 836 Rd Norfolk, Nebraska, Madison County, Nebraska. The applicant is requesting a lot split of 5.73 acres to build a home. The property is in an Ag Intensive district which allows for 2 homes per quarter section. This will be the 1st home allowed. Ms. McWhorter advised that the property received unanimous approval from Planning and Zoning Board.

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR CERTAIN LAND LOCATED IN THE COUNTY OF MADISON, NEBRASKA UNDER AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE MADISON COUNTY ZONING AND SUBDIVISION RESOLUTION AND LEGISLATIVE BILL 186 (1978)

WHEREAS a recommendation has been received from the Madison County Joint Planning Commission and

WHEREAS notice of public hearing was published in the June 24, 2023, edition of The Norfolk Daily News, and a public hearing was held by law.

WHEREAS, the Madison County Joint Planning Commission and the Madison County Board of Commissioners have established the following Statement of Finding of Facts:

1. This application is consistent with the Madison County Comprehensive Plan, Zoning and Subdivision Regulations and the Zoning Map.
2. The property is zoned A1 Agriculture Intensive and meets the density requirements for the Zoning district.

This Conditional Use Permit shall be subject to the following conditions in addition to those established with the Madison County Zoning and Subdivision regulations:

1. This Conditional Use Permit is permanent and may be transferred between owners.
2. This Conditional Use Permit allows a single-family home on less than 40 acres.

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3. With the passage of this permit, the applicant and/or residence builder realizes that the new residence is going to be subject to livestock odors, dust, and general nuisances. This does not mean that the applicant is giving up the right to be protected by Madison County and the State of Nebraska.
4. The applicant should be aware it is his responsibility to remove any Nebraska Noxious Weeds found on the property at any time after the approval of this application by the County Board of Commissioners.
5. A copy of the signed permit must be recorded with the County Register of Deeds office by applicant.
6. A zoning permit must be obtained from the Zoning office before construction begins on the residence.

Public Defender Matthew Headley was present to request the Board of Commissioners to consider for the breakroom/kitchen area to be included with the entryway remodel project. Mr. Headley explained that the staff is currently using a hotplate to prepare meals for themselves. One of the concerns is having the appropriate electrical outlets for the appliances. At this time the current electricity can't handle the microwave and hotplate at the same time. If this project could be included it could save the County dollars if done now since d.w.b. Construction Company would be there working on the project that was approved on April 11, 2023. Mr. Headley stated that the breakroom/kitchen area pricing included cabinetry, plumbing, and electrical specific to plans dated February 1, 2023. After further discussion, the Board approved adding the breakroom/kitchen area.

Motion made by Schmidt and seconded by Uhlir to approve the breakroom/kitchen area up to \$20,000 for the Public Defender's office located at 104 South Main Street, Madison, Nebraska. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Absent, Stinson. Motion carried.
