

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

RESOLUTION FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE OFFICES OF THE MADISON COUNTY ASSESSOR AND THE MADISON COUNTY REGISTER OF DEEDS

WHEREAS, NEB. REV. STAT. §24-417 allows for the consolidation of certain county offices, including the office of county assessor and register of deeds; and

WHEREAS, NEB. REV. STAT. §24-417 further provides for the steps to be undertaken to achieve said consolidation; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Board did, on November 20, 2023, at 2:00 o'clock p.m., conduct a public hearing, after notice as provided for by law, on the question of whether Madison County should consolidate the offices of Madison County Assessor and Madison County Register of Deeds; and

WHEREAS, following said public hearing, the members of the Madison County Board of Commissioners determined that it would be in the public interest to consolidate said offices and that the issue of consolidation of the offices of Madison County Assessor and Madison County Register of Deeds should properly be submitted to the registered voters of Madison County, Nebraska, for approval at the next general election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Madison County Board of Commissioners that the offices of Madison County Assessor and Madison County Register of Deeds should be consolidated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Madison County Board of Commissioners that the question of the consolidation of the offices of Madison County Assessor and Madison County Register of Deeds shall be submitted to the registered voters of Madison County, Nebraska for approval at the next general election in the following form:

"Shall the offices of Madison County Assessor and Madison County Register of Deeds be consolidated into one consolidated office according to the resolution adopted by the county board of Madison County, Nebraska, on November 20, 2023? Yes No."
