COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

Madison, Nebraska

December 19, 2023

The Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Nebraska met in regular session at 9:30 A.M.

Advance notice of meeting was published in the Wednesday, December 13, 2023 edition of The Norfolk Daily News and posted on the Madison County website. A copy of said notice was provided to each Board member. An affidavit of acknowledgment of receipt of notice of meeting as published was executed.

Following a moment of Silence and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, Chairman Troy Uhlir called the meeting to order and notified the public of the copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the meeting room.

Present: Commissioners Eric Stinson, Ron Schmidt, and Troy Uhlir, County Clerk Anne Pruss, County Highway Superintendent Richard Johnson, County Attorney Joe Smith, County Sheriff Todd Volk and Carey Hopkins from Community Based Grant/ Juvenile Accountability. Norfolk Daily News reporter Jon Humphries, WJAG reporter Paul Hughes, and NCN reporter Ryan Pattee were present.

Commissioner Schmidt read the following consent agenda items into the record:

- 5) Authorization to purchase 2024 John Deere 644 P-Tier Wheel Loader from Murphy Tractor & Equipment Co., Sioux City, Iowa for Road District #1, in the amount of \$327,800.00
- 6) Authorization for County Board Chairman to execute the Community Based Juvenile Services Aid Grant, and 2024-2025 Memorandums of Understanding between Madison County and Antelope, Boone, Knox, Pierce, Stanton, and Wayne Counties
- 7) Authorization for County Board Chairman to execute agreement regarding payment and ownership of DS450 High-Throughput Scanner and Tabulator

Motion was made by Stinson and seconded by Uhlir to approve the consent agenda. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, Stinson, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Stinson and seconded by Schmidt to approve the regular agenda. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, Stinson, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.

Pursuant to published legal notice in the September 20 and 27, and October 4, 2023, editions of the Norfolk Daily News, Chairman Schmidt opened a public hearing at 9:35 A.M. to receive comments regarding the vacation or abandonment of part of the county road running from the South 1/4 Corner to the North 1/4 Corner of Section 11, Township 23 North, Range 4 West of the 6th P.M., Madison County, Nebraska, said road being 538 1/2 Avenue running from 838th Road to 839th Road. As directed by Resolution No. 2023-58 adopted on November 20, 2023.

Chad and Allen Korth spoke in favor of vacation or abandonment of said road.

No one spoke in opposition.

The public hearing was closed at 9:37 A.M.

No action was taken.

Speaking on behalf of the organization, Norfolk Area Transit, board members Jan Einspahr, Chuck Waite, Julie Sweeney stated that grant funding is necessary for NFAT to continue growing as planned and that public transit is more important than ever in the community. She stated that the board has some members after what had occurred with Mr. Stewart. She stated that the Norfolk Bus Service has served portions of the County for over 57 years providing services to individuals that don't have transportation to get to doctor appointments, to purchase groceries, and service the disable. According to Ms. Einspahr, NFAT has received an offer of \$2.1 million in Federal and State grant financing; however, in order for the funding to be granted, the organization needs to generate 20% in community matching funds. which totals \$378,250. She stated that the match certainly can't depend on the people that use the service, so, we need to solicit from businesses and communities.

While Chairman Troy Uhlir acknowledged that county officials recognized the need for funding for NFAT, he clarified that, as part of the original agreement with the county, a one-time contribution of \$750,000 with ARPA funds was given to be used for the purchase of a property and bus maintenance, which would reduce the organization's future rental and maintenance overhead. Additionally, it was agreed that NFAT would extend its reach to include towns located further outside of Norfolk. According to county officials, NFAT never fulfilled any of those agreements. Ms. Einspahr advised that she was unaware of an agreement that was in place in June of 2022 under Mr. Stewart's control. County Clerk Anne Pruss stated that she would provide a copy of the agreement to Ms. Einspahr. Mr. Uhlir stated that the contributions made by the County were to help purchase a building and provide funding. By doing this it would reduce the long term costs such as rental space, mechanical work, and other services needed. In return, Madison County would have bus services to other areas in exchange. Chairman. Uhlir stated that services would serve Tilden,

Meadow Grove, Battle Creek, and Newman Grove. County Attorney Joe Smith stated that in the agreement the County would receive annual or semi-annual report to the board, along with all kinds of provisions for accountability.

Chairman Uhlir also expressed confidence in the NFAT's new general manager, Julie Sweeney, and stated that it will take time to "rebuild those bridges" in order for the transport to receive extra financing. It's also critical for the county to determine where the missing cash went and for NFAT to recognize that the county engaged into a contract with the organization and the terms of that contract are still in effect. Chairman Uhlir remarked, "Until we have more information and see how this turns out, I personally am not ready to commit to providing funding at this time." Ms. Einspahr asked that if the contact stated a one-time gift and the organization couldn't ask for funding again and Chairman Uhlir stated yes. Chairman Uhlir stated that reading past minutes he was unsure if the county would have been anywhere near that level that was given.

No further discussion.

No action taken.

Highway Superintendent, Richard Johnson updated the board on Project No. C59-812, located at 1st and Nucor Road. He stated they will get the final drafts back soon and wanted to put a 4 inch base course under the concrete. He stated that the 1st street asphalt is 10 1/2 inches thick and the Nucor asphalt is approximately 5 1/2 inches thick. He also stated that the condition of the soil will have to be looked at and hoping that that the county won't have the soil modification like Nucor Road. Commissioner Ron Schmidt asked what the road would be like and Mr. Johnson advised that 1st Street would be three lanes with the exception near Industrial Highway would have four. There would be two northbound lanes up to the crush plant driveway and one southbound lane. At Industrial Highway, there will be a right turn lane into an acceleration lane so trucks can get up to speed without slowing oncoming traffic down. Chairman Uhlir asked if we would have to move the power lines and Mr. Johnson stated that there is no plans to do so. Commissioner Eric Stinson asked if Stanton County was involved and Mr. Johnson explained that they were pushing on that going forward. Mr. Johnson commented that they will open the bids for this on project January 11, 2024 and award the job on January 17, 2024.
