The Board of Equalization of Madison County, Nebraska met at 9:00 A.M.

Advance notice of meeting was published in the Wednesday, April 2, 2024, edition of The Norfolk Daily News. A copy of said notice was mailed to each Board member. An affidavit of acknowledgment of receipt of notice of meeting as published was executed. Chairman Eric Stinson called the meeting to order and notified the public of the location of the information regarding the Open Meeting Act posted in the meeting room.

Present: Commissioners Ron Schmidt, Eric Stinson, and Troy Uhlir, County Assessor Jeff Hackerott, and County Clerk Anne Pruss.

Motion made by Schmidt and seconded by Uhlir to approve the minutes of the November 4, 2025 meeting. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, Stinson, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.

Pursuant to published legal notice in Wednesday, November 26, 2025, edition of the Norfolk Daily News, Chairman Stinson opened a public hearing at 9:00 A.M. to receive testimony regarding new permissive exemption application of Norfolk Soccer Club, Inc., Norfolk, Nebraska.

County Assessor Jeff Hackerott explained new organizations are required to file a Form 451 exemption application form. He reported that organizations qualify for exemption if the property is:

- 1) Owned by educational, religious, charitable or cemetery organizations
- 2) Used exclusively for educational, religious, charitable or cemetery organizations
- 3) Not owned or used for financial gain or profit to either the owner or user
- 4) Not used for the sale of alcoholic beverage for more than 20 hours per week; and
- 5) Not owned or used by an organization which discriminates in membership or employment based on race, color, or national origin

Chairman Stinson opened the scheduled hearing at 9:01 A.M. regarding the request from the Norfolk Soccer Club for approval of a permissive exemption for property recently transferred to the organization. County Assessor Jeff Hackerott provided background information on the exemption request. He explained that the parcel had previously been owned by Paul Abler, an exempt owner, and was transferred to the Norfolk Soccer Club on September 11, 2025. For permissive exemption requirements to be met, the property must have been exempt prior to transfer and the transfer must occur between July 1 and the levy-setting date, typically October 20. Mr. Hackerott stated the transfer met all statutory criteria.

County Assessor Jeff Hackerott further reported that the Norfolk Soccer Club submitted the required filing to his office on October 27, 2025, well in advance of the November 15 statutory deadline. He reviewed the exemption qualifications, noting that the property is not used for any activity involving financial gain, the club does not sell alcohol on the premises, and the property is not leased to outside organizations. All required elements for permissive exemption had been satisfied, and he indicated there were no concerns or objections from the Assessor's Office. No additional testimony was offered.

At 9:03 AM, Chairman Stinson formally closed the public hearing. He then called for a motion on the exemption request.

Motion was made by Schmidt and seconded by Uhlir approve application Reaffirmation of Tax Exemption filed by Norfolk Soccer Club, Inc.. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, Stinson, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried

Chairman Stinson adjourned the meeting at 9:05 A.M.

Following a moment of Silence and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, Chairman Troy Uhlir called the meeting to order and notified the public of the copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the meeting room.

Present: Commissioners Ron Schmidt, Eric Stinson, and Troy Uhlir, County Clerk Anne Pruss, County Highway Superintendent Richard Johnson, and Zoning Administrator Heather McWhorter. Norfolk Daily News reporters Ben Drozd was present and fourteen citizens were in attendance.

Commissioner Stinson read the following consent agenda items into the record:

- 1) Approval of minutes of November 19, 2025
- 2) Authorization for County Board Chairman to execute agreement to NACo for annual 2026 membership
- 3) Approval of White's Second Lot Split in Section 15-22-1 located at the intersection of Highway 81 and 831st Road, Madison County, Nebraska
- 4) Authorization for Sheriff department to purchase two 2026 Ford Interceptor on State Contract from Courtesy Ford in the amount of \$47,206.00 each

Motion made by Stinson and seconded by Schmidt to approve the consent agenda for the meeting. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, Stinson, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.

Motion made by Stinson and seconded by Schmidt to approve the regular agenda for the meeting. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, Stinson, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.

Pursuant to published legal notice in Thursday, November 20, 2025 edition of the Norfolk Daily News, Chairman Troy Uhlir opened a public hearing at 9:33 A.M. to receive public comments concerning the application of Perfect Circle Irrigation for an irrigation business on property to be described as White's Second Lot Split in the Southwest corner of the SW ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 15, Township 22 North, Range 1 West of the 6th P.M., Madison County, Nebraska. Parcel is located at the intersection of Highway 81 and 831st Road, Parcel # 590135952.

Planning and Zoning Administrator Heather McWhorter stated that the applicants are requesting to build a commercial building on the corner of the above parcel; the lot split will be presented to the board for consideration at the time of this hearing. The building will be used to operate an irrigation business consisting of a service technician, salesman and secretary. This is the Zimmatic business for Summit, previously Petersen Ag and they also have stores in Sutton and Central City. They have also opened the Osmond store back up. This is in an Ag Intensive zoning district and is allowable as Conditional Use. I received a phone call with concerns regarding the county road that will be used for access. It was discussed at the hearing and planning was not concerned after discussion with the applicant. No opposition at the hearing.

Ms. McWhorter read the Statement of Finding of Facts.

1. The application is consistent with the Madison County Comprehensive Plan.
2. The application is consistent with the Madison County Subdivision Regulations.
3. Business operating with three employees and occasional customers on site.
4. This is an A1 Ag Intensive zoning district and is allowable use with a Conditional Use Permit.

Recommended Conditions:

1. This permit is for an irrigation business.
2. This Conditional Use Permit is for period of 10 years and will be renewed automatically with no verified complaints.
3. This permit shall be registered against the lot deed with the Madison County Register of Deeds by the applicant once approved.
4. No building may be built until first receiving a building permit from Madison County Zoning.
5. Applicant must follow **all** local, state, and federal laws if applicable.
6. All zoning requirements to include but are not limited to signage and parking must always be followed.

Jon Zoucha spoke in favor of the application.

No one spoke in opposition to the application

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR CERTAIN LAND LOCATED IN THE COUNTY OF MADISON, NEBRASKA UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE MADISON COUNTY ZONING AND SUBDIVISION RESOLUTION AND LEGISLATIVE BILL 186 (1978)

WHEREAS a recommendation has been received from the Madison County Joint Planning Commission and

WHEREAS notice of public hearing was published on November 20, 2025, edition of The Norfolk Daily News, and a public hearing was held by law.

WHEREAS, the Madison County Joint Planning Commission and the Madison County Board of Commissioners have established the following Statement of Finding of Facts:

1. This application is consistent with the Madison County Comprehensive Plan, Zoning and Subdivision Regulations and the Zoning Map.
2. The property is zoned AG1 Agriculture Intensive and is allowable with Conditional Use.

3. Business will operate with three employees and occasional customers on site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Nebraska, hereby grant a Conditional Use Permit to Perfect Circle Irrigation for an irrigation business on WHITE'S SECOND LOTSPLIT property to be described as:

WHITE'S SECOND LOTSPLIT in the Southwest corner of the SW ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 15, Township 22 North, Range 1 West of the 6th P.M., Madison County, (See attached)

This Conditional Use Permit shall be subject to the following conditions in addition to those established with the Madison County Zoning and Subdivision regulations:

1. This permit is for an irrigation business.
2. This Conditional Use Permit is for period of 10 years and will be renewed automatically with no verified complaints.
3. This permit shall be registered against the lot deed with the Madison County Register of Deeds by the applicant once approved.
4. No building may be built until first receiving a building permit from Madison County Zoning.
5. Applicant must follow all local, state, and federal laws if applicable.
6. All zoning requirements to include but are not limited to signage and parking must always be followed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT REFERENCED, that upon taking effect of this Resolution, the above Conditional Use Permit shall be entered and shown on the Official Zoning Map of Madison County, previously adopted by reference, and said zoning map is hereby reincorporated as a part of the Madison County, Nebraska Zoning and Subdivision Resolution as amended.
