## COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

Madison, Nebraska

February 24, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners of Madison County, Nebraska met in regular session at 9:30 A.M.

Advanced notice of meeting was published in the Wednesday, February 18, 2026 edition of the Norfolk Daily News. A copy of said notice was mailed to each Board member. An affidavit of acknowledgment of receipt of notice of meeting as published was executed.

Following a moment of Silence and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, Chairman Troy Uhlir called the meeting to order and notified the public of the copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the meeting room.

Present: Commissioners Eric Stinson, Ron Schmidt, and Troy Uhlir, County Clerk Anne Pruss, County Highway Superintendent Richard Johnson, County Sheriff Todd Volk, and Road Foremen Jeff Schroeder and Neil Kreikemeier. Norfolk Daily News reporter Austin Svehla was present. Five citizens were in attendance.

Commissioner Uhlir read the following consent agenda items into the record:

- 1) Approval of minutes of February 10, 2026 meeting  
Approval of illumination lighting for the Courthouse from X Trimlight LLC in the amount of \$10,442 (**Item removed from consent to regular agenda.**)
- 2) Approval of bridge construction agreement with Doug A. Brandl to replace structure No. C005903330 located on 550th Avenue between Sections 10 and 11, Township 22 North, Range 2 West, part of the N ½ of the NE ½ and part of the S ½ of the NE ¼ of said Section 10
- 3) Approval of Pieke Bin Site Lot Split located in Section 18-22-4, 83110 Hwy 45, Newman Grove, Madison County, Nebraska
- 4) Acknowledge receipt of the Official Bond and Oath of Rebecca L. Wallin as Treasurer of School District of Newman Grove Public School
- 5) Acknowledge receipt of cancellation of interlocal agreement with City of Newman Grove for project on Hale Avenue and Highway 45
- 6) Acknowledge receipt of report from Mainelli Wagner & Associates, Inc. for routine inspection 183 bridge structures for 2025

Motion made by Stinson and seconded by Schmidt to approve the consent agenda for the meeting. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, Stinson, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.

Motion made by Schmidt and seconded by Stinson to remove the consent agenda item concerning illumination lighting for the Courthouse from X Trimlight LLC in the amount of \$10,442 and place it on the regular agenda for further discussion and action. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, Stinson, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.

Motion made by Schmidt and seconded by Stinson to approve the regular agenda for the meeting. Roll call vote: Ayes, Schmidt, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried. Absent: Eric Stinson

Pursuant to published legal notice in the February 4, 11, and 18, 2026 edition of the Norfolk Daily News, Chairman Uhlir opened at public hearing at 9:34 A.M. to receive citizens' comments regarding the road construction program for 2026 and the six-year road improvement plan.

County Highway Superintendent Richard Johnson reported that State law requires the County to file a one and six year road improvement plan with the Board of Classifications and Standards prior to March 1st of each year. He explained that the plan outlines the projects to be completed in year one and proposals for the following five years. A map was distributed during the hearing which reflected the locations of the proposed projects. The Board reviewed the County's One-Year and Six-Year Road & Bridge Plan as presented by the County Highway Superintendent Richard Johnson. Mr. Johnson began discussion with the One-Year Plan outlines projects scheduled for the upcoming fiscal year based on roadway conditions, bridge inspection reports, traffic counts, and safety priorities. The Superintendent reported that the following projects are included in the 2026 One-Year Plan:

- Asphalt overlay resurfacing of 5 or 6 miles that carried over from 2025 Projects and should begin April 1st.
- Current overlay projects
  - Boone County line of 3 ¼ miles in conjunction with Boone County
  - Deer Run Road
  - Battle Creek East in Battle Creek and east to 547<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Meadow Grove SW from 839<sup>th</sup> from 536<sup>th</sup> to 539<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- Replacement of 9 or 10 Bridge due to structural deficiencies noted in the most recent inspection.
- Culvert replacements or repair on Nucor Road to address drainage concerns and prevent roadway washouts.
- Bridge No. 03330 located three miles west and little bit south by Enola are driving test pilings today.
- Box Culvert No. 2005 south of Meadow Grove Project No. C-59-847 might begin work in the next 2 or 3 weeks.
- Bidding of 4 or more overlay projects in the next month:
  - Ag Rex Road
  - Andy's Lake Road
  - Terra Heights Road
  - West of Eisenhower and 37<sup>th</sup> Street to 49<sup>th</sup> Streets
  - Cemetery Road to Hwy 45 that comes out of Newman Grove

- Project No. 960 northeast corner of the county will extend the paving from Norfolk Crush over to Victory Road then South to the viaduct
- Project No. BRO-7059(17) Apple Orchard Bridge should be bid this year with 90% Federal and 10% State funding.
- Pork Plant Bridge
- Battle Creek Bridge.

Estimated costs and funding sources were reviewed, including County Road Fund revenues, Highway Allocation Funds, motor vehicle tax receipts, and potential cost-share funding where applicable. The Superintendent advised that the projects listed are achievable within the fiscal year, subject to weather conditions and material availability.

The Six-Year Plan was then presented, outlining anticipated transportation improvements for the period 2026 through 2031. The Superintendent explained that the Six-Year Plan is a planning document that allows the County to strategically schedule major capital improvement projects and coordinate with state and federal funding programs.

The Board noted that projects included in the Six-Year Plan may be modified annually based on funding levels, grant awards, emergencies, or changing infrastructure conditions.

No one from the public spoke during the public hearing. Chairman Uhlir closed the hearing at 9:45 A.M.

After discussion, the following resolution was introduced:

## RESOLUTION #2026-12

WHEREAS, pursuant to published legal notice, public hearing on the one year and six year Road Improvement Programs for Madison County was held, and

WHEREAS, Richard C. Johnson, Madison County Highway Superintendent has presented the one year and six year Road Programs, and

WHEREAS, said Road Programs, as presented, have been given due consideration,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the one year Road Program and the six-year Road Program, as presented, are hereby accepted.

Motion was made by Schmidt and seconded by Stinson that the foregoing resolution be adopted. Roll call vote: Ayes, Stinson, Schmidt, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.

The Board next discussed illumination lighting for the Courthouse. Discussion was held regarding exterior architectural lighting improvements to enhance building visibility, safety, and security. Cost estimates, installation requirements, and potential energy usage were reviewed. It was noted that the proposed lighting would improve nighttime visibility of the Courthouse grounds and entrances.

Following discussion, motion was made by Schmidt but didn't received a second failed. The Board agreed to further review cost estimates and funding options. The matter was tabled pending receipt of detailed proposals and financial analysis, with plans to revisit the project at an upcoming meeting.

The Board then considered issuing a Notice to Proceed to Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD) to begin the procurement process for power line relocation associated with Project No. BRO-7059(17). The relocation is necessary to accommodate planned bridge improvements under the referenced project. The Board discussed coordination timelines to avoid construction delays and confirmed that relocation costs are eligible under the project funding structure.

Motion was made by Schmidt and seconded by Stinson to issue a Notice to Proceed to Nebraska Public Power District to begin procurement and relocation activities for Project No. BRO-7059(17). Roll call vote: Ayes, Stinson, Schmidt, and Uhlir. Nays, none. Motion carried.
